Why focus on underage alcohol and tobacco use?

Research provides more reasons than ever for parents and other adults to be alarmed about the effects of underage drinking and tobacco use on Texas children. Among Texas youth, alcohol is the primary drug of choice – nearly double the use of other substances. Tobacco continues to be second. Both are gateways to other drug use and risky behaviors linked to truancy and low test scores. Come learn about proven steps for community action to prevent and reduce youth access and availability to these substances.
